Thailand is a beautiful country with a rich culture, just south of China. People call it "the jewel of south-east Asia" for a good reason. Its tropical climate, white sandy beaches and ancient temples make it a perfect holiday destination. What makes it special, though, is its people. Thai people are good-looking. They are short with delicate features. They have got black hair, dark eyes and light brown skin. The Thais are friendly people who are well known for being 'generous and kind. "We are a happy people who have strong wills and are especially proud of our history," says Kasem from Bangkok.
