C	<p>La Merced</p> <p>What: La Merced is a huge market in Mexico City and the main focus is food. You can also buy other goods, such as shoes or kitchen equipment. This is not a place to visit in a hurry — the market is inside a huge building and it's easy to get lost. There are plenty of places to eat street food inside. It's cheap and popular with local people as well as tourists.</p> <p>Don't miss: Try specialities like mole (a sauce) and <i>quesadillas</i> (a type of thin bread filled with cheese).
